Best possible investment

– It is a tough and volatile market, and I need to stay competitive. I always look for the best possible investments and I constantly try to optimize my business. I have always been troubled by a drop in performance in the cages closest to the side wall air inlets in my existing houses with negative pressure ventilation. Especially during winter this always causes stressed birds and performance drop says Volodymyr.

A quite different system
